SEPA Rate Adjustments

Georgia-Alabama-South Carolina System Rate Adjustment

On September 4, 2012, the Deputy Secretary, Department of Energy confirmed and approved on an interim basis new rate schedules for the Georgia-Alabama-South Carolina System. The rate schedules were forwarded to FERC with a request for approval on a final basis. Notice of interim approval was published in the *Federal Register* (77 FR 55817) on September 11, 2012. The new rate schedules are effective October 1, 2012. The new rates for capacity, energy, and generation services are as follows:



Capacity:	\$4.81	/kW/Month
Energy:	12.33	Mills/kWh
Generation Services:	\$0.12	/kW/Month

Cumberland System Rate Schedules

Rate schedules for the Cumberland System were approved by FERC through September 30, 2013. Southeastern is in the process of evaluating options for the rate schedules that would be effective October 1, 2013.

Alliance Meeting Held



A Southeastern Federal Power Alliance (Alliance) meeting was held October 2 in Atlanta, GA. Representatives with the Georgia-Alabama-South Carolina customers, Corps of Engineers' South Atlantic Division, Mobile District, Savannah District, Wilmington District, USACE headquarters, DOE headquarters, and SEPA attended. Tentative plans are to hold the next meeting in March 2013. Details regarding the meeting date and location will be forthcoming once finalized.

Customer Funding

Georgia-Alabama-South Carolina Customer Funding

The Project Review Committee agreed to amend Sub-Agreement #9 to increase the cost of the work item (Allatoona Switchyard) by \$7,750,000, for a total cost of \$13,000,000. Due to funds available from closed-out Sub-Agreements #4, 6, 9, and 14 and an amendment to Sub-Agreement #15, the total amount of additional funds required for the Allatoona Switchyard were \$1,468,695.47. Letters were mailed to participating customers of customer funding for the Georgia-Alabama-South Carolina System.





GEORGIA-ALABAMA-SOUTH CAROLINA SYSTEM Energy-In-Storage 2011 - 2012




GA-AI-SC System FY 12 Cumulative Net Generation

PLANT AVAILABILITY/CAPACITY UPDATE: AUGUST - OCTOBER 2012

GA-AL-SC System:

Allatoona (35 MW):

- Customer-funded work item
- Unit #1 out of service due to transformer failure
- According to Corps, Unit #1 scheduled to return to service by end of February 2013

Carters (132 MW):

- Unit #2 unavailable for three weeks due to biennial inspection from late October through mid November 2012

Russell (164 MW):

- Customer-funded work item
- Installation of new main circuit breakers and static start systems for Units #7 and #8 underway
- According to Corps, work is scheduled to be completed by mid December 2012

Millers (26 MW):

- Unit #2 out of service through first of November 2012 for quadrennial inspection

Walter F. George (80 MW):

- Unit #1 and Unit #2 unavailable due to replacement of transformers
- According to Corps, work is scheduled to be completed in March 2013

Cumberland System:

Wolf Creek Dam Safety Issue:

- Dam safety repairs continue on schedule at the project
- According to Corps, work is scheduled to be completed by December 2013

Center Hill Dam Safety Issue:


- Work continues on the barrier wall at the project
