## In Memoriam

Denver L. (Lee) Rampey, Jr., passed away at his home April 2, 2012. Lee was General Counsel for Southeastern from 1981-2011. He retired from Southeastern on December 31, 2011, where he worked for 31 years. Lee received his undergraduate degree from Emory University and attended the Walter E. George School of Law at Mercer University where he received his Bachelor of Law in 1968. He served as both the U.S. Attorney and Assistant U.S. Attorney for the Middle District of Georgia, practiced law with the late Peyton S. Hawes Sr. of Elberton, and was a partner with Nunn, Geiger & Rampey in Warner Robins and Perry, prior to his employment with Southeastern.



## SEPA Rate Adjustments

### Georgia-Alabama-South Carolina System Rate Adjustment

On March 7, 2012, notice of a proposed rate adjustment for Southeastern's Georgia-Alabama-South Carolina System was published in the Federal Register (77 FR 13594). The proposed rate adjustment is an increase of about 10 percent in the revenue requirement and approximately 15 percent in the capacity and energy rates. A public comment and information forum was held Tuesday, April 24, 2012, in Atlanta. Written comments are due on or before June 5, 2012.



## Customer Funding

### Georgia-Alabama-South Carolina Customer Funding

In November 2011, the Project Review Committee approved Work Item No. 16, which provides funds for the generator rewinds for units #3 and #4 at the Carters Powerhouse. The total funds to be collected through customer funding under this work item are \$35 million. The collection of funds began with the April 2012 power bills from Southeastern and will continue until the full amount is collected.



The execution of the sub-agreement for Work Item No. 16 was completed on March 29, 2012. Letters were mailed to participants of the Georgia-Alabama-South Carolina System customer funding.





## Hartwell Celebrates 50th Anniversary


Friday, April 27, marked the 50th anniversary of the first power on-line at the Hartwell Project.



## GEORGIA-ALABAMA-SOUTH CAROLINA SYSTEM Energy-In-Storage 2011 - 2012




## GA-AI-SC System FY 12 Cumulative Net Generation
