




Freddie E. Baker was hired by SEPA to fill the Supply Clerk vacancy, effective July 29, 2012.



## GEORGIA-ALABAMA-SOUTH CAROLINA SYSTEM Energy-In-Storage 2011 - 2012




## GA-AI-SC System FY 12 Cumulative Net Generation

# PLANT AVAILABILITY/CAPACITY UPDATE: MAY - JULY 2012

## GA-AL-SC System:

### Allatoona (35MW):

- Customer-funded work item
- Unit #1 out of service due to transformer failure
- Unit scheduled to return to service by June 2013

### Carters (156 MW):

- Customer-funded work item
- Unit #3 declared unavailable on July 5, 2012 due to field pole coil damage
- Unit scheduled to return to service by the first of August 2012

### Walter F. George (80 MW):

- Units #3 and #4 unavailable to replace main transformer and 15kV switch gear
- Units scheduled to return to service August 8, 2012

## Kerr-Philpott System:

### John H. Kerr:

- Customer-funded work item
- Replacement of high voltage cable system
- With the return of Unit #4 on April 30, 2012, cable replacement is complete on all units

## Cumberland System:

### Wolf Creek Dam Safety Issue:

- Final panel (433rd) installed, completing protective concrete embankment wall
- Main barrier wall scheduled to be completed by December 2013

### Center Hill Dam Safety Issue:
